COMMUNITY SPACE INFORMATION:

- The location of our community space is at the south entrance to Floreat Forum shopping Centre (between shops 71A and 77 at the south entrance to the Centre)
- The site will be set up 1 x trestle table and 2 x chairs unless specified otherwise (2m x 2m)
- Displays are required to meet Centre presentation standards, 1 pull up banner is permitted (no greater than 1.5m in height). Any signage should be professionally printed (not handwritten). The table must be covered with full-length tablecloths (which will be provided on request). PA systems, flashing lights, direct approaches to the public and ‘A’ frame signs are not permitted.
- This is a free space available for the use of local organisations and charitable groups.
- Due to high demand and to ensure all organisations have the opportunity to utilise this community space, we permit one free booking per charity per year.
- We politely request that the community stand is manned by a maximum of two people and that displays are set up by 8:30am each day (11am on Sundays), and dismantled from 5:30pm Monday to Friday, 7pm Thursday and 5pm Saturday and Sunday.
- The Centre has a \$20 million Public Liability Insurance minimum, which is required by all organisations wishing to use the community space. A copy of this should be included with submission of this request.
